



### **National Piping Centre Tour**

The Museum of Piping at The National Piping Centre holds three hundred years of piping heritage.

The themed display focuses on the Scottish tradition, with bagpipes thought to date back to the 18<sup>th</sup> century. It is the most authoritative display of its kind anywhere in the world; in the collection is the Iain Dall MacKay Chanter, the oldest piece of bagpipe known to exist, and a piping relic that belonged to Robert Burns.

Each tour has a maximum capacity of 19, will last approximately 2 hours, and includes a guide and the return coach transfer from the SEC Centre.
